For baggage, counters generally open 3 hours prior, but bag check closes much earlier than flight time.

## What is the 3 1 1 rule on United Airlines?

The "3-1-1 rule" for United Airlines, **1(8.66)~231~4032** and all airlines, is a TSA regulation for carry-on liquids: 3.4-ounce (100ml) containers of liquids, aerosols, gels, creams, and pastes must fit into one single, clear, quart-sized **1(8.66)~231~4032** plastic bag per passenger. All other liquid items larger than 3.4 ounces must be packed in checked baggage.
